Mandatory Language for Monitoring/Reporting Violation Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR) MONITORING, ROUNTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE

The MORTON VALLEY WSC PWS ID 0670018 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period Fourth Quarter 10/01/2024 – 12/31/2024.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: Fourth Quarter 2024 was monitored. The report was completed on 01/10/24 but failed to mail report to TCEQ. As of 04/09/2024 the report has been filed.
