

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)**  
**MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The MORTON VALLEY WSC water system PWS ID 0670018 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period(s) 10/01/2025 -12/31/2025

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

During this time water was properly disinfected before distribution, maintained and monitored residuals throughout system. We did not file report until 03-23-2026.

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Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses).
